The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.110 dated 07.04.2020 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that pursuant to the order dated 16.09.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation, the matter has otherwise been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Hans Raj, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of

the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the matter has been compromised between the parties and her custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 16.09.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
