1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for taking action against the respondents for intentionally, deliberately and willfully disobeying order dated 03.02.2020, in CWP No.2859-2020, in case titled as Manohar Lal Bathla vs. State of Haryana and others.

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order Annexure P/1 dated 03.02.2020, CWP No.2859 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the authorities to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.03.2019 in accordance with law and take appropriate action thereon, if not already taken, after giving opportunity of hearing to all affected parties, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, but despite lapse of aforementioned period of time, needful has not been done.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has

placed copy of order dated 30.10.2020, on record, rejecting the petitioner's representation dated 25.03.2019. The same is taken on record, copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that he does not press the Contempt Petition and prays that the same may be disposed of as such with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 30.10.2020, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as not pressed with the liberty as prayed for.
