The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.527, dated 18.04.2020 registered under Sections 120-B, 409 and 420 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

Vide order dated 18.09.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Mahal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to submit that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
