The matter is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. The detinue, namely Vaishali, is present in the Chamber of Mr. B.S. Sewak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, for interrogation with this Court. He, in response to the Court's query submits that the said lady/detinue is alone in his Chamber and was not accompanied by any of her family members.

3. The detinue submits that her previous statements (Annexures P-4 and P-6) were given by her under compelling circumstances at the instance of the petitioner and his family members, and not voluntarily. She further submits that being an adult, she is not interested to go with the petitioner and wants to stay on with her parents, where she is not being forcibly detained against her

wishes.

4. In this view of the matter, this does not appear to be a fit case for taking any further action pertaining to any attempts at “recovery” of the detainee, who being an adult is herself not inclined to accompany the petitioner.

5. Dismissed.
