On 17.9.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No. 0127 dated 24.08.2020, registered under Section 323, 324, 354, 148 & 149 IPC, at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

As per the case of the prosecution, there was scuffle between the members of two families who are closely related to each other. The dispute appears to be arising from ownership of a school.. It has been noticed that a cross version has also been registered by the petitioners against the first informant and the others. It is also not disputed that the injuries caused are simple.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Court, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to seek instructions.

Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the first informant.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to let the petitioners join investigation.

In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on interim pre-arrest bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction

of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List on 07.10.2020.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and are not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 17.9.2020 is hereby made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.
