1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, against the respondents for willful and deliberate disobedience of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.05.2019, in CWP No.21736/2015.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents states that Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.746 of 2020, has vide order dated 11.11.2020, stayed the operation of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.05.2019 as well as orders dated 20.11.2019 and 01.08.2016, therefore, in the circumstances, no orders are called for in the Contempt Petition at this stage and the same may be disposed of as such.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the circumstances, he does not press the Contempt Petition at this stage and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to

move an application for revival of the Contempt Petition if the circumstances of the case so warrant, pursuant to the decision of the LPA.

5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.
