With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner for release of the performance bank guarantee. It is observed that the petitioner has invoked Clause 56 of the contract, vide notice dated 3.7.2020 (Annexure P-20), seeking arbitration, and the issue is pending before the authorities in this regard.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, submits that the petitioner has invoked the arbitration clause and the authorities shall proceed to decide the matter, by taking a decision thereon, in accordance with law, expeditiously.

In view of the aforesaid, as the petitioner has already invoked the arbitration clause and the authorities are in the process of considering and deciding the same, we do not find any reason to entertain this petition by way of parallel proceedings.
