Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.108 dated 27.12.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on vide rapat No.18 dated 06.04.2020), registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Gurbachan Singh, petitioner No.1 Jagga Singh caused injuries with gandasa on his left ear. It is further submitted that in the incident, even the petitioners have suffered simple injuries.

Learned State counsel has submitted that there are five victims and they have suffered number of injuries and injury No.1 caused by the petitioner on the body of Gurbachan Singh was declared grievous injury.

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After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the petitioners are the main accused, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court and prays that a direction be issued to the trial Court to dispose of their regular bail application expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioners surrender before the trial Court and move an application for regular bail within a period of 07 days from today, the trial Court will decide the same within 03 days thereafter.
