Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of his real brother namely, Bhajan Singh and his nephew namely, Amarjit Singh s/o Bhajan Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that they have a joint property and Bhajan Singh and his son Amarjit Singh are not allowing the petitioner to operate the tube-well, which is on the joint property. It is further submitted that Sukhdev Singh, another brother of the petitioner, tried to persuade Bhajan Singh and his son Amarjit Singh, but despite that they had inflicted injuries upon the petitioner. In this regard, attention of the

this Court is drawn to the MLR dated 24.5.2020 (Annexure P-2).

The counsel for the petitioner further states that though DDR No.10 dated 27.05.2020 was registered by the police, yet no further action has been taken in the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further states that the petitioner has given a representation dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2, but till date no action has been taken thereon. He further states that he would be satisfied, if representation dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) is decided by respondent No.2, as per law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh Dullat, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
