This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This is the second petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. For grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.96 dated 26.06.2019, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act (later on Sections 29 and 25 of NDPS Act have been added), registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

The previous petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 13.07.2020.

Counsel has been heard at length.

As per prosecution version, based on a secret information a truck bearing registration No.PB-46-M-8917 was intercepted and which led to the recovery of 800 kgs.of poppy husk.

Present petitioner was apprehended on the spot being the driver of the truck. One co-accused Hardeep Singh @ Deepa who was conductor of the truck was also arrested on the spot.

During the course of arguments it has gone uncontroverted that CRM-M-20401 of 2020 filed by co-accused Hardeep Singh @ Deepa seeking regular bail has been dismissed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 10.08.2020.

Prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is declined on the same very reasoning as contained in order dated 10.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-20401 of 2020.

Petition dismissed.
