[1] Claim in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to grant the benefit of Kurukshetra University Self Financing Scheme Rules to the petitioner for the period 02.12.2006 to 10.05.2012 i.e. the period during which the petitioner worked as Assistant Professor in Law in respondent No.2-College.

[2] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the parties are in agreement that the Managing Committee of Chhajju Ram Law College, Hisar, District Hisar be also impleaded as respondent No.3 and the writ petition be disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide representations (Annexures P-6 to P-8) dated 05.12.2012, 18.12.2012 & 12.02.2013, in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, Managing Committee, Chhajju Ram Law College, Hisar, District Hisar through its President is impleaded as respondent No.3 and the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide representations (Annexures P-6 to P-8) dated 05.12.2012, 18.12.2012 & 12.02.2013, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
