1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.192 dated 05.07.2020, registered under Sections 21/61 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Bhawnigarh, District Sangrur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 17.09.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned Addl. AG, Punjab, on instructions from *SI Karamjit Singh, Incharge Narcotics Cell*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 17.09.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail, no recovery is to be made from him and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned Addl. AG, Punjab, order dated 17.09.2020, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
