Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.12 dated 16.01.2018 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

At this stage, learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 has argued that recovery of gold articles is yet to be effected in the case.
