1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Reply of the respondent as filed by way of affidavit dated 01.12.2020 along with Annexures R-1 & R-2 is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite order dated 25.08.2020, disposing of CWP No.12644 of 2020 by directing the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner for promotion, the same was not done, therefore, the contempt petition was filed but subsequently order (Annexure R-2) dated 13.10.2020 was passed, rejecting the claim of the petitioner and in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to challenge order (Annexure R-2) dated 13.10.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.

5. Accordingly, in the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed, with the liberty as prayed for.
