The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to hand over investigation of FIR No.58 dated 13.05.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and also counter DDR No.56 dated 11.05.2019, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur to the Central Bureau of Investigation or some senior police officer.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur is directed to look into representation dated 4.8.2020 (Annexure P-8) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior

Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to look into representation dated 4.8.2020 of the petitioner (Annexure P-8) and decide the same after hearing the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
