The case has been taken up through video conferencing on account of Covid-2019 pandemic.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.84, dated 20.04.2020 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Lalru, District Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners, on the basis of compromise dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Vide order dated 17.09.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 29.09.2020 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 09.10.2020 of learned JMIC, Dera Bassi has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Dera Bassi and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.84, dated 20.04.2020 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Lalru, District Mohali and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners, are hereby quashed.
