The petitioner contends she is having a small newly born baby to look-after, thus, causing immense hardship which is sought to be displaced by the learned counsel for the respondents Ms. Harsh Rekha Kapoor, AAG, Haryana by placing reliance on **CWP No. 13602 of 2020** titled as **Ram Chander Vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 04.09.2020, **LPA No. 247 of 2020 (O&M)** titled as **Nisha Vs. State of Haryana** decided on 24.02.2020, **CWP No. 14046 of 2020** titled as **Ashok Kumar Sharma Vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 10.09.2020, **Union of India and another Vs. Deepak Niranjana Nath Pandit** 2020(3) SCC 404 and **CWP No. 13907 of 2020** titled as **Rahul Sharma and another Vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 11.09.2020.

Be so as it may, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the petitioner to first make representation to the respondents within week from today regarding relief being claimed in this petition and upon doing so, the respondents will consider and dispose off the same, by a

speaking order preferably, within the period of one month upon receipt of copy of the said representation, in accordance with law and which would be conveyed to the petitioner.
