1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the Petition under Sections 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for taking action against the respondents for non-compliance with order dated 20.12.2019, passed in CWP No.8899 of 2017.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide annexure P/1 dated 20.12.2019, the writ petition was allowed, petitioner was held entitled to be considered for selection and appointment as per merit on the basis of selection process faced by her, and the Commission was directed to declare the result of the petitioner and depending upon the result so declared, to take such further action in accordance with law, as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case, within six weeks but that despite expiry of the aforementioned period of time, needful has not been done.
4. Learned Addl. AG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 28.10.2020, forwarded by the Commission to the Director General, Secondary Education, Haryana, recommending the name of the petitioner for appointment

to the post of PGT (Home Science). The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in the circumstances, he does not press the Contempt Petition any further.

5. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
