Prayer in this 3rd petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.15 dated 31.01.2020 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa.

The earlier one was dismissed on 22.07.2020, noticing the fact that there are 06 more FIRs pending against the petitioner under the NDPS Act.

The allegation in the FIR are that the police party on suspicion stopped a lady with the help of other police officials and a lady Head Constable Kulwinder Kaur and she disclosed her name as Amarjeet Kaur (petitioner herein). After giving a notice, she was searched with the help of the lady Head Constable and 03 Kgs. of poppy husk was recovered from the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is a lady and she is in custody since 13.01.2020.

Counsel for the State has filed the Custody Certificate

today in the Court and submits that as per the Custody Certificate, though, the petitioner is in custody for the last 07 months but she is involved in FIR No.194 dated 10.10.2019, FIR No.112 dated 27.11.2017, FIR No.37 dated 07.02.2005, FIR No.161 dated 26.07.2013, FIR No.23 dated 19.03.2009 and FIR No.41 dated 13.07.2011, which are pending before the Courts.

After hearing the counsel for the parties and looking into the serious allegations against the petitioner, who appears to be a habitual offender and also the fact that she is involved in 06 more cases/FIRs, I find no ground to grant the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
