MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA (ORAL)

By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has made a prayer for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect her life and liberty as she apprehends threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 because in February 2020, she was thrown out of her matrimonial house by her husband, respondent No.8, who used to torture her, physically as well as mentally and her brothers were reluctant to keep her at her parental house and hence, she has started staying in Narnaul in a rented accommodation against the wishes of the private respondents. A further prayer has also been made to direct respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh to look into and consider the representation dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) moved by her in this regard.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, Additional A.G., Haryana, at the asking of the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the State has no objection for the same.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the said matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and her husband, respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Mahendergarh, is hereby directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1) and if it is found that the petitioner genuinely deserves any protection, then to take appropriate action in accordance with law. However, it is clarified that this order shall not be construed to be a shield to the petitioner against any action taken or intended to be taken by the competent authority or person on account of the said matrimonial dispute and permissible under any relevant provisions of law.

This petition stands disposed of.
