This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners seek benefit of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.38 dated 05.08.2016, under Sections 341, 506, 364-A, 365, 344, 346, 384, 385, 386, 411 and 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 30 of Arms Act, Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.
