Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing
due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. prayer has
been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide the
police protection to the petitioner and its employees, for execution and
performance of its business at Selling Food Products/place of business.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose
would be achieved if respondent No.3 – Superintendent of Police,
Ferozepur, is directed to look into the representation dated 14.08.2020
(Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after
perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case,
instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 –
Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to look into the representation of the

petitioner (Annexure P-1) and decide the same after hearing the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
