Present petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 26.05.2017 (P-3), passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Bathinda, whereby the application under Order 9 Rule 13 of the Code of Civil Procedure for setting aside the *ex parte* order dated 07.04.2005 as well as *ex parte* judgment and decree dated 09.04.2005 has been dismissed. Further challenge is to the judgment dated 11.04.2019 (P-1), passed by learned Additional District Judge, Bathinda, vide which, the aforesaid order dated 26.05.2017 of learned trial Court has been affirmed.

Case called twice, but none appeared on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present case.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
