The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.115, dated 7.7.2020, registered under Section 382, 34 IPC at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

As per the case of the prosecution, three persons with muffled faces snatched gun of a security guard after injuring him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no admissible evidence against the petitioner and he is sought to be indicted as an accused on the statement of Naresh, who has stated that he has overheard the conversation between the other accused in the case. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that such evidence is highly improbable.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, has brought to the notice of this Court that the petitioner is not a man of clean past. Apart from the present case, there are three more criminal cases pending against the petitioner. He further, submits that the remaining two accused have been arrested and they have made a statement that the gun in question is in possession of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Hence, dismissed.
