The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/Nigam to grant the ACP revised scales on completion of 10 years regular service on the post of driver as per ACP Rules, 2008.

Learned counsel the petitioner submits that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 27.02.2020 to the respondents and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice, dated 27.02.2020 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case and considering the limited prayer made, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take note of the contents of the legal notice and to decide the same by passing a speaking order, within a period of 6 months from today.
