The present petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 16.05.2020 (Annexure P-2) and for giving direction for granting parole to the petitioner.

The only ground taken in this petition is that petitioner is behind the bar since the date of FIR dated 14.05.2015 but despite that he was wrongly not granted the benefit of parole. A perusal of the impugned order reveals that the main reason for rejection of the parole is that co-accused of the petitioner was granted parole in the year 2019 but the said co-accused had committed a serious crime and therefore, it is apprehended that petitioner can also commit such type of crime. However, this reason is not completely germane.

In the circumstances, order Annexure P-2 is set aside and District Magistrate, Ludhiana, is directed to pass a fresh order in accordance with law within two weeks on receipt of certified copy of this order.
