Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.714, dated 24.12.2018, registered under Section 420/406/506120-B IPC, at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fetehabad.

The petitioner was granted concession of anticipatory bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, vide order dated 05.02.2019 while directing him to join the investigation as and when called upon by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner, thereafter, failed to comply with the directions of the Court with respect to joining the investigation. Even on an application filed by the Investigating Officer before the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad seeking cancellation of the bail, the petitioner failed to appear although notice was issued. The petitioner neither joined the investigation nor appeared before the Court. Ultimately, the

petitioner was served through affixation. Since, the petitioner still did not appear before the Court, therefore, compelled by the circumstances, the Court passed the order cancelling the concession of pre-arrest bail on 31.10.2019.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner has prima facie, misused the process of the Court.

Hence, no ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail, once again to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
