The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner-Vipral Kaur for issuance of directions to respondent nos. 2 and 3 to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

It is averred in the criminal writ petition that respondent No.4, who is nephew of the petitioner, had looted her and had taken her to Delhi. However, he had raped her and consequently he had put the petitioner into prostitution against her wishes. Relating to the said conduct of the private respondents, she had moved representation dated 04.09.2020, copy whereof Annexure P-1, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa, but no action is being initiated.

Notice of motion.

Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that he may be granted four weeks' time to decide the representation dated 04.09.2020(Annexure P-1).

Considering the offer so made by learned counsel for the respondents-State, which is just and reasonable and also acceptable to learned counsel for the petitioner, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take decision viz-a-viz grievance of the petitioner, as detailed in representation dated 04.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) within a period of four weeks from today onwards.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
