The instant revision petition has been filed seeking to challenge the order dated 27.02.2019 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurdaspur (Camp Court Batala).

In brief, the facts are that an application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. was filed against the petitioner herein before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurdaspur and a total interim maintenance was fixed @ 12000/- per month to four applicants namely Rama Rani-wife of the petitioner, Poonam - minor daughter, aged 17 years, Karan -minor son aged 15 years and Vicky- minor son aged 14 years.

Aggrieved against the said order, the instant revision petition has been filed on the ground that the interim maintenance awarded is on the excessive side.

A perusal of the file would reveal that the instant petition has been filed after a delay of 70 days which was condoned and the petitioner

on 12.07.2019 undertook to clear 50% of the entire arrears of maintenance due till date within a period of three weeks from that date. Consequently, the revision petition was listed for compliance on 25.09.2019, on which date there was no appearance on behalf of the petitioner as well as there was an office note which stated that the order dated 12.07.2019 had not been complied with. Consequently, the Court adjourned the matter to be taken up today.

The matter has been taken up today and despite having been called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner nor is there any compliance of order dated 12.07.2019.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
