The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.596 dated 22.10.2013, under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad.

Counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the allegations as set out in the FIR are vague and general in nature, while also contending that co-accused i.e. his parents have already been acquitted by a detailed judgment dated 06.03.2017 given by the JMIC, Fatehabad, clearly holding that there is nothing on case file to suggest accused have threatened the complainant with death, while further holding that there is no

incriminating evidence against the accused on the case file, consequently, the trial court has found them not guilty. It is argued that the FIR was registered at the back of the petitioner, while he was residing in New Zealand.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, AAG Haryana, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State. She opposes the quashing of the FIR, while arguing that he is the husband of the complainant, therefore, should face trial.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and do not find any ground to quash the FIR. The petitioner has already put in an appearance before the trial court, which is seized of the proceedings. At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the trial court to decide the matter preferably within a period of 08 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
