This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This is the fourth attempt made by the petitioner in terms of filing the instant petition seeking benefit of regular bail in FIR No.064 dated 04.04.2018, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

The last petition i.e. third petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. bearing No.CRM-M-18619 of 2020 was dismissed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.07.2020 in the following terms:-

“Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in

a case arising from FIR No.64 dated 04.04.2018, registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Heard.

Considering the heavy recovery of contraband, falling under the category of “commercial quantity” and less custody period of petitioner, no ground exists for entertaining this petition.

Dismissed. No further petition for grant of regular bail to petitioner shall be entertained till conclusion of trial.”
