Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Paramjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dhuri, District Sangrur, which is accompanied with the statement of the petitioners Puneet Sharma and Rajina. As per the reply, the petitioners have made a statement that they have no threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents.

In view of the reply so submitted by the State, the present petition has rendered infructuous.
