After arguing for some time counsel submits that he does not press the petition and prays for liberty to file the same, in case there is any threat to life from the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are the parents of petitioner No.2. The said persons are residing in Mysore, Karnataka and respondent No.4 is stepfather of petitioner No.2 and in such circumstances prima facie can be in no position to threaten or harm the petitioners on the account of them having married. It has been averred that petitioner No.2 is a graduate and working as Radar Operator in Air Force and is earning about Rs.30,000/- per month.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with the above said liberty.
