1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Affidavit of Sh. Paramjit Singh, Director Public Instructions (Colleges) Punjab, on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.
3. Prayer in the petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful violation of order Annexure P-1 dated 20.07.2020 in CWP No.10077 of 2020.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order Annexure P-1 dated 20.07.2020 in CWP No.10077 of 2020, the respondents have passed orders dated 22.10.2020 and 19.11.2020 and in view thereof, he does not press the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge the aforementioned orders by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
5. The same is not opposed by learned AAG, Punjab.

6. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage with the liberty as prayed for.
