Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that despite registration of FIR No.0015, dated 01.02.2020 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar, the investigation in the said case is moving at the snails pace as even after passing of almost eight months, challan has not been presented. It is asserted that highlighting these aspects, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) to the Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar-respondent No.2 but that has not yielded any result.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law and

complete the investigation in the abovesaid FIR within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 19.08.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
