The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 to 4 to revise the pension of the petitioner and release the arrears and allowances from the year, 2012 along with interest. Prayer has also been made directing respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 07.02.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to file a comprehensive representation for the relief claimed in the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

However, in case the petitioner submits a comprehensive representation for the relief claimed in the present petition with the authorities within one month from today, the authorities shall take note of the said representation and shall pass a reasoned order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of such representation.
