The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner -Resmi wife of Nura praying for issuance of direction to the official respondents to register FIR against the private respondents and also to secure her life and liberty.

It is stated in the petition that on 24.07.2020, a dispute had taken place between two rival groups in the village, relating to which FIR bearing No. 134 dated 24.07.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 302, 379-A, 506, 427, 285 and 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, had been registered at Police Station Bicchor and in the said FIR, husband of the present petitioner was falsely involved. Also, it is the claim of the petitioner that the private respondents had entered into her house and had looted the house hold and valuable articles. Even, her two rooms were demolished. Relating to the same, she approached the local police, but no action has been initiated against them.

It is submitted that the petitioner had filed an application dated 21.08.2020 with the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh, respondent no.2, but no action is initiated. The said application is placed on record as Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Harpreet Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana has made appearance on behalf of the respondents-State and has assured that the said application, which is Annexure P-2 shall be decided by the concerned authorities within a period of three weeks.

In view of the assertions so made and the assurance given by learned State Counsel, the present criminal writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to decide the application dated 21.08.2020(Annexure P-2) within a period of three weeks from today onwards and to pass appropriate order, in accordance with law.

However, these observations of mine are circumscribed only for the purpose of disposal of the present criminal writ petition and shall not be construed as expression on merits of the FIR in question and shall also have no effect upon the civil or criminal proceedings, pending between the parties concerned.

Accordingly, the criminal writ petition stands disposed of.
