MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA J. (ORAL)

By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have approached this Court with a prayer for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to take immediate action against respondents No.5 to 16 as they are unnecessarily harassing and have also beaten them in-conivance with respondent No.17 and are threatening them to either hand over the vacant possession of the land which is already the subject matter of civil litigation or to face the music. It has also been mentioned in the petition that the petitioners have moved complainants/representations to the police authorities (Annexures P-7 and P-8) to seek the redressal of their afore-said grievance but in-vain.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Jaspreet Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer to issuance of a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn-Taran to look into the representation/complaint as moved by petitioner No.1 to him i.e. Annexure P-7.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Accordingly, without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the civil litigation as stated to be pending between the parties regarding the disputed land, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn-Taran is hereby directed to look into the complaint/representation (Annexure P-7) as moved by petitioner No.1-Jasbir Singh to him on 02.09.2020 and if found necessary, then to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

However, it is clarified here that nothing contained in this order shall be construed to be a shield to the petitioners against any action already initiated or intended to be taken by the competent Authority/person in respect of the matter as narrated in the said representation (Annexure P-7) and permissible under any relevant provisions of law.

The petition stands disposed of.
