[1] The petition is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.20 dated 21st January, 2018 under Sections 323, 427, 506 read with Section 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 325 and 354 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar.

[2] The bail application was dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide order dated 1st March, 2018.

[3] Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits on

instructions from ASI Gurjeet Singh that Sections 325 and 354 of IPC have been deleted and rest all the sections are bailable.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made today, petitioner will approach the police authorities with the bail bonds.
