1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0041 dated 01.07.2020 registered at Police Station Women Police Station Rewari, District Rewari under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 21.09.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioner Sachin and also of complainant Deepika have

been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Deepika in her statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0041 dated 01.07.2020 registered at Police Station Women Police Station Rewari, District Rewari under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
