(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to ensure release of detainee Amanpreet Kaur from illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

The petition has been filed on the grounds that the petitioner solemnized marriage with detainee-Amanpreet Kaur on 11.09.2020 but after marriage respondents No.4 and 5 have taken her into their illegal custody.

Vide order dated 17.09.2020, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala was directed to look into the matter, locate the girl and produce her before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording of her statement and to file status report.

In compliance with the above said order, status report was filed by way of affidavit of Vikram Jeet Duggal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala. In the status report, it has been mentioned that in her statement before Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, detenue Amanpreet Kaur has stated that she had solemnized marriage with the petitioner and wanted to go with him. Accordingly, detenue Amanpreet Kaur was allowed to go with the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that now detenue Amanpreet Kaur is residing with the petitioner and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
