MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty and further restraining respondent Nos.4 and 5 from interfering in her personal life.

Learned counsel submits that petitioner was married with Neeraj Soin in the year 2005 and out of this wedlock, one son was born who is presently 14 years old. The petitioner is residing in her matrimonial house. He has further submitted that respondent Nos.4 and 5 are parents in-law of the petitioner and are harassing her at the instance of their daughters. He submits that the respondents abused the petitioner and gave her beatings. According to him, the representation dated 09.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Panipat, wherein no action has been taken so far. He prays for issuance of necessary directions to official respondents to provide her protection.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any merit in the prayer as admittedly parties are living together in the same house. Even the grown up son of the petitioner is residing with the

grand-parents and the allegations as contained in the representation do not make out a commission of any cognizable offence. The petitioner has not made any prayer in the representation for providing her any protection.

Resultantly, no case is made out for interference and the same is dismissed.
