Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on
account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 21.09.2020, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.309, dated 24.08.2020, registered under Section 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh (Mewat).

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner ran away on seeing the police party when he was bringing two weak oxen for the purpose of slaughtering.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a man of clean antecedents and he is sought to be falsely implicated. He further contends that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 05.10.2020.

On the request of this Court, Mr. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel appearing for the State, on instructions from SI Bacchu Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the interim order dated 21.09.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
