The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.64 dated 06.04.2018, registered under Sections 186, 307, 332, 353 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the State submits that the entire prosecution evidence has already been led in this case. The case is now fixed for recording of the statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.; for 10.11.2020. Hence, the trial of the case itself is going to be concluded.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere at the stage so as to grant the bail pending trial to the petitioner.

However, it is directed that the trial Court shall make endeavour to dispose of the trial itself as expeditiously as possible.
