1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned counsel states that promotions to the post of Superintendent on regular basis are held up on account of non-finalisation of seniority of Senior Assistants despite objections having been filed by various persons on 14.06.2018 in response to the tentative seniority list.

3. Learned counsel states that the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to finalise the seniority list of Senior Assistants in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

5. Ms. Sunint Kaur, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, in the light of the position as noticed above and without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement

directing respondent No.2 to finalise the seniority list of Senior Assistant’s after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months of date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
