The petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty, as they apprehend danger from respondents No.4 and 5.

Reply by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarter Kaithal, District Kaithal has been filed by learned counsel for the State, wherein it has been stated that vide respective statements (Annexures R-1 and R-2) made by the petitioners, they do not apprehend any danger from the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement made by the petitioners, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
