1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for taking action against the respondents for violation of order (Annexure P-1) dated 15.01.2020 in CWP No.211 of 2020.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the learned State Counsel has furnished copy of order dated 24.11.2020, releasing part of the benefits to which the petitioner is entitled and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 24.11.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law *qua* the claim which has not been granted.

4. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.

5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed with the liberty, as prayed for.
