By this common order, this court shall dispose of above
captioned two petitions for grant of regular bail i.e. CRM-M-28877 of 2020

titled as *Ram Pal @ Rampal Pal vs. State of Punjab* and CRM-M-33938 of 2020 titled as *Virsa Singh vs. State of Punjab*, as the same arise out of the same FIR.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners pray for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.109 dated 07.05.2020, registered under Sections 15, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, which is opposed by counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State. She, on instructions from ASI Puran Chand, would submit that a huge recovery of poppy husk was effected from the petitioners herein and the FIR was registered only in the month of May, 2020 and charges have already been framed in the matter.
