The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.113 dated 22.08.2020 registered under Sections 379, 411, 489 of IPC (Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC added lateron) at Police Station Division No.4, Patiala, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 05.10.2020, petitioner No.1-Sanjay Pal @ Sayanj Pal was released on interim bail whereas the present petition qua petitioner No.2-Manoj Kumar was withdrawn by the counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 05.10.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner No.1 has joined the

investigation and has been admitted on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jatinderpal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 05.10.2020 whereby the interim bail granted to petitioner No.1 is made absolute.
