This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.6 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 28.08.2020 to respondents No.2 and 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh and Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Lalit Kumar Gupta, Additional Public Prosecutor, U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 3 and Mr. Vivek Saini, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2, 4 and 5. Complete copies of paperbook have been supplied to them.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.3 and 4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh and Superintendent of Police, Kaithal respectively to consider representation dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P/3) and issue necessary orders, as warranted by law, so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.
